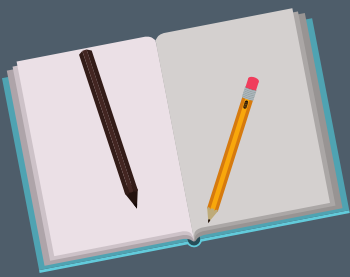

## The Challenge

## GDPR and SharePoint

Organisations will only have 72 hours to report a data breach to the authorities. In addition GDPR includes provisions for fines of up to 4% of global annual turnover or 20 million euros, whichever is higher.
