On 1st October 2018, Microsoft announced the release of its latest Dynamics NAV update, along with a change of name to 'Business Central'.



From 1st April 2019, only Business Central will be available, which also means the end of concurrent licences for new customers.



From 1st April 2019, you will only be able to upgrade to Business Central with Normal Users. However, for each existing (purchased before 30th September 2018) full user of NAV, you will get 2 Named Business Central On-Premise Users... + the latest all-in-one business management solution on the market.
