

The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) Compliance Statement

The EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) will become enforceable on May 25, 2018 and will standardize data privacy and protection laws across Europe. It will also reach beyond Europe, as it applies to any entity that processes personal data tied to offering goods or services to, or monitoring behaviour of, European data subjects.

TSG is aware of our obligations as a data controller and processor under the GDPR and we are working to ensure that all TSG products and services to which the GDPR applies will be compliant when enforcement begins in May 2018.

TSG has always prioritized the privacy and security of the content we protect with our applications and services. As part of our GDPR compliance efforts, we will continue to refine, improve and document our security measures to protect against unauthorized access, use or disclosure of the content we protect.

GDPR compliance will be a responsibility of all data processors and data controllers, including those that administer and use TSG products. TSG is committed to making our products and services compliant, so our customers can continue to use our products and services with confidence, in a manner that supports their own compliance efforts.

Regulatory guidance on the GDPR from European data authorities is still evolving, and we are closely monitoring how the GDPR's personal privacy rights will be interpreted in the context of the services we provide. As this evolves we will continue to follow the latest guidance in our policies, terms and processes.
